Helpful Info You Need to Know:

- Check In: Camp check in begins at 9:00am each day at the main entrance to the church. Each child will be given their ID lanyard which they must wear at all times.
- Pick Up: You will need to sign your child out each day from their teacher when you pick them up.
 Children will only be released to individuals listed on your child's registration form. Please have photo identification ready for pick up.
- <u>Lunches:</u> We will provide deli style sandwiches, lunchables, fruit, and a vegetable for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. On Friday, we will have hot dogs. Your child is welcome to bring their own lunch on any or all of these days, but please make sure their name is clearly marked on the bag.
- <u>Field Trips:</u> T-shirts are required for our field trips on Tuesday (Steele Creek), Wednesday (Just Jump), and Thursday (Rocky Mount). Children are also required to wear the name ID we provide. Transportation is provided and we will do our best to return to the church by the designated pick up time.
- Ages Eligible for Camp Discovery: Camp Discovery is for children who have completed 1st grade through completed 6th grade.
- Cost: The cost for the week is \$55 per child. This includes food, field trips, transportation, materials for craft time, and a camp t-shirt. If your child loses or destroys his or her camp ID lanyard a new one will be required at a cost of \$1.00. Registration due by May 22. There will be a \$10 late fee for all registrations turned in after May 22. Camp shirts may not be available if you sign up after this date.

- <u>Parking:</u> When dropping off or picking up your child please park in a parking space and walk your child to check in. Please do not pull up and park in front of the church or sidewalk.
- Clothing: We ask that your child wear shoes, not flip flops or sandals. Flip flops and sandals are fine on the Friday, Water Day. Camp t-shirts will be given out on the first day. Also make a note of the back page and what is needed for specific field trips.
- <u>Curriculum:</u> The purpose of Camp Discovery is to teach basic Biblical truths to your child. The Bible will be our curriculum. Pastor Adam Sells will be leading our Bible Time.
- <u>Daily Activities:</u> Each day will begin with an exciting worship time and Bible lesson with all the campers together. After this the campers will rotate to different areas including recreation, music, and craft. Following a morning filled with fun and learning will be lunch time. After lunch we will load the buses and head out on our afternoon field trips.
